

MEET OF CHAMPIONS JUNE 28th and 29th, 2008

Basic Swim Meet Instructions:

The meet will be held at the Katy High School Natatorium. Preliminaries will be held on Saturday, June 28th and Finals are on Sunday, June 29th. Please allow ample time for parking and walking as there are over 700 swimmers plus parents from 7 teams in attendance as well as a Jehovah Witness Convention taking place next door at the Merrill Center. Make sure you get plenty of sleep beforehand and prepare for some great competition! Events are held in the same order as our regular meets.

Willow Fork will have an assigned area located outside the Natatorium. This is where our age group ready bench parents will be stationed. Please ask your child to remain at the Willow Fork ready bench area until they are called to the League ready bench, and return to this area after they swim. This is very important. There is no way to come search for them when their event is up. There will also be an assigned area inside the Natatorium where the swimmers can go to watch the swim meet. Only ONE PARENT is allowed in that designated area during the meet. We will talk further about this at our Parent Meeting Thursday during your child's practice time.

Bring a chair, quilts or blankets for you and your swimmer. Bring cards, books, or games, mosquito repellent, water misters, radios, ipods, mp3 players (permitted only if used with headphones). Please contact Claudia Walter or Becky Anton if you have tents that you can bring and set up.

Concessions will be available. For sale will be Barbeque sausage, chicken and sandwiches, Dippin Dots, Bahama Mamas, candy, chips, and drinks.

FYI: The League assigns each team a particular duty that they are "in charge" of. Willow Fork was assigned "Awards" for the meet. We also are being asked to help in other areas such as judging, timers, ready bench and security.

T-shirts will be for available for sale throughout the weekend if you chose not to pre-order. However, you may want to purchase yours as soon as the meet opens!

Heat Sheets will also be available for a fee.

Willow Fork swimmers will warm up at 8:00am.

9:00am National Anthem and welcome speech.

9:15 am Meet begins. Meet ends about 11:30am.

12:30 pm ages 11 & up ARRIVE at Willow Fork area ON TIME!

Willow Fork swimmers warm up at 1:00.

2:00pm National Anthem and welcome speech.

2:15pm Meet begins. Meet ends by 5:00 pm.

Anyone qualifying in the preliminaries (the top 8 finishers) will return on Sunday. Please check the posted meet results at the Natatorium before you leave on Saturday to see if you are coming back on Sunday. If your swimmer is on a relay, he/she will definitely return for the finals on Sunday because there are 7 teams...

10:30 am – All swimmers qualifying in the preliminaries arrive at Willow Fork area

11:00am Warm up

12:00 National Anthem, Welcome and Awards

12:15 pm - Meet Begins

Awards will be given on Sunday, immediately following each race.

All Volunteers will report and check in with Claudia Walter. She will be located at the Willow Fork outdoor tent area.

Saturday morning volunteers will check in at 7:45am and will need to report to the pool deck at 8:30am.

Saturday afternoon volunteers will check in at 12:45pm with Claudia Walter and will need to report to the pool deck at 1:30.

Sunday volunteers will report to Claudia Walter at 10:45am and will need to report to the pool deck at 11:30am.
